Dear Sirs

The FMJD Section 64 in accordance with the calendar of the Section 64 competitions in 2011 holds Personal-team Youth World Championship in draughts 64. Championship will held in Tallinn (Estonia) from August 12, (arrival) till-August 21, 2011.

Championship is held separately for boys and girls in four age groups: juniors born in 1992-94, the cadets born in 1995-97, the junior cadets born in 1998-00 and hopes born in 2001 and later, in the three types of programs: the classic game - with time control 45 minutes till the end of the game plus 10 seconds on each move, the rapid game with time control 10 minutes till the end of the game plus 5 seconds on each move, and the blitz game with time control 3 minutes (participants born 1998 and younger - 5 minutes) til the end of the game plus 3 seconds on each move.

System of competition is Swiss or round robin, depending on the number of participants.

All programs are held in the Russian version of draughts 64 in the system of micro-matches consist of two games. In the junior and the cadets competition holds the draw of the first move of the white binding on both games of the micro-match. In summarizing the results of the command places the commands are defined by the maximum amount of points scored 8 best players (one from each age group for boys and girls) compete in the classic game. Also summarizes the results of the command separately for boys and girls teams for the most amounts of points scored by the best 4 players (one in each age group) in the competitions on the classic game.

European and World champions of any years, the winners of World Championship-2010 and European Championship-2011, the participants claimed by national federations are allowed to participate in Personal-team Youth World Championship.

Each participant of the competitions should immediately pay organizational tournament fee at the day of arrival: three representatives of each country in every age group among boys and girls - 45 (forty five) euros for participating in the program with classical time control, 10 (ten) euro in the blitz program and 10 (ten) euro in the rapid program. For other players tournament fee is 90 (ninety) euros for the program with classical time control and 20 (twenty) euro for the blitz and for rapid program. The organizational committee provides with accommodation and meals on four participants from each country (one in each age group). Their travel costs, as well as the costs of food, accommodation and travel of other participants pays by their sending organizations.

All participants must have medical insurance for the period of competition.
